



## **Burlington Built Heritage Awards**

### ***To Recognize the Preservation and Renovation of our Architectural Heritage***

Every year, Heritage Burlington sponsors the Burlington Heritage Building Awards, recognizing property owners who have contributed to the preservation of our built heritage for the use and enjoyment of present and future generations.

**The Restoration Award** is given for a completed project that preserves a heritage building by means of maintenance or restoration that respects the original design, details and materials.

**The Renovation Award** is given for a project that preserves a heritage building or neighbourhood through a renovation or an addition in a way that enhances and is compatible with the original building or surrounding neighbourhood. The undertaking may be large or small and have been designed and completed as a do-it-yourself project, or by professionals.

#### **Award Nominations:**

Anyone can make a nomination for their own home or another person's home provided that it satisfies the criteria established by the judges.

#### **Judging Criteria:**

- The building or neighbourhood must be at least 50 years old
- Only exterior work visible from the street will be judged
- Quality of maintenance
- Respect for original building materials
- Use of restored or reproduction period details
- Quality of craftsmanship
- Compatibility with original proportions and design
- General enhancement of the neighbourhood or community
